CALABASAS, Calif. — Authorities say a car driven by the U.S. ambassador to Malta crashed into a drainage ditch in Southern California, killing a nun and injuring a 94-year-old pastor.

The nun and pastor were passengers in the car driver by Ambassador Douglas Kmiec (kah-MEK'), 58, the California Highway Patrol said. Kmiec also suffered moderate injuries in Wednesday's one-vehicle crash.

CHP Officer Leland Tang said Kmiec was driving a Hyundai Accent on Mulholland Highway near Calabasas when the car veered into a drainage ditch and crashed.

Sister Mary Campbell, 74, of Our Lady of Malibu Catholic Church died at the scene, while Pastor Emeritus Monsignor John Sheridan received moderate injuries, Tang said.

The three had attended an anniversary celebration at a Woodland Hills high school and were returning to the church when the crash occurred, The Malibu Times reported.

Our Lady of Malibu Parish Manager Peggy Thomas told the newspaper that Sheridan underwent surgery and was in critical but stable condition. Kmiec also underwent surgery and was in stable condition, the Times reported.

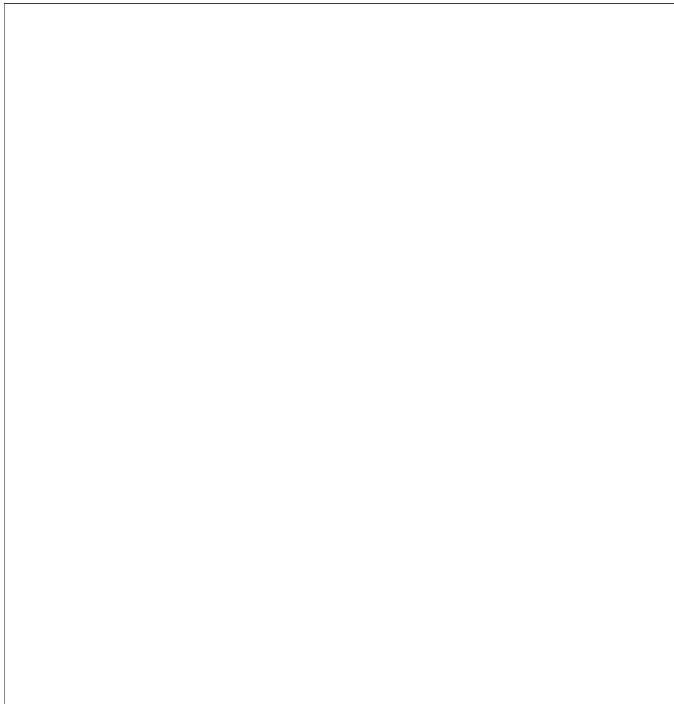

On Thursday, September 16, a bipartisan supermajority of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee voted to recommend the New Strategic Arms Reduction Treaty (New START) for ratification by the full Senate. Senator Jim DeMint couldn't be bothered to stay for the final vote, but during committee debate, he said, "If we are going to move ahead with the commitment not to protect the people of the United States, I think everyone in this country ought to know it."

Senator DeMint's comment raises the singular issue regarding New START, and any other national security treaty: does it make America safer? Senator DeMint clearly thinks not-and, in fact, that the Treaty is a "commitment not to protect" our country.

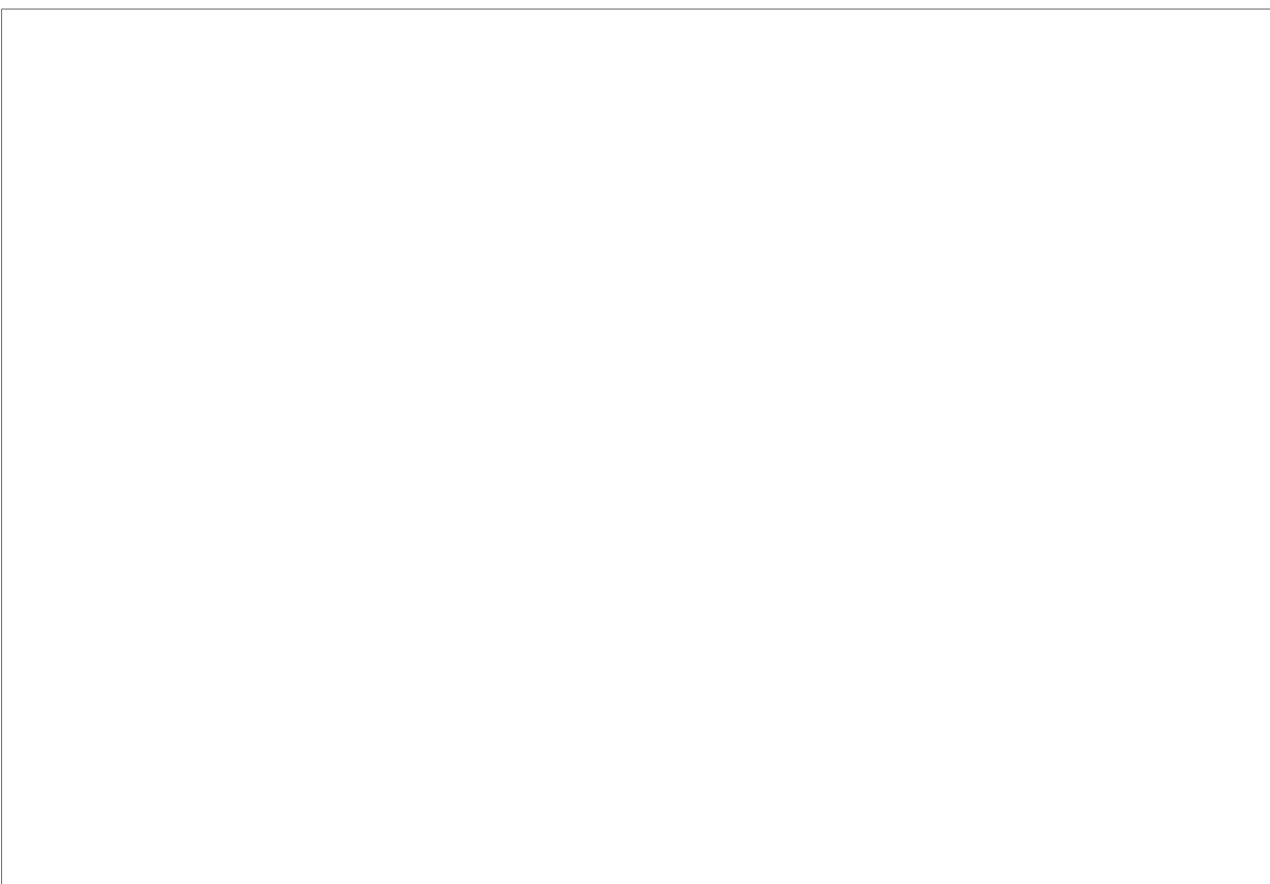

[1] HR is checking with OPM to find out where the Authorization Document is for the 5/five new N/C-SES

[2] As we have discussed, with the President's recent decision to suspend discretionary bonus payment for Non-Career personnel, it is unclear what will happen in the future.

Currently, GS-15s are capped at \$155,500, which is the same as Executive Level-IV [Presidential appointees of Assistant Secretary rank]. Their salaries cannot go up unless the Congress raises Executive Level salaries by legislation.

Currently, SES-non-career salaries range from \$119,554 to \$179,700. And the \$179,700 level is capped there, which is the same as Executive Level-II [Deputy Cabinet level]. Their salaries cannot go up unless the Congress raises Executive Level Salaries by legislation.

If someone, was converted from GS-15 to SES their salary would go up by \$8,250. But it could never increase as once in the SES you get no cost of living raise and one is now ineligible by Presidential directive for Performance Pay.

If one stayed as a GS-15, one might get a 2-3% raise annually, if the President's so authorized for all GS employees. Such a raise would be worth anywhere from \$3110 - \$4665 at 2-3% annually.
